## Rajbari College Principal, wife, son stabbed

FARIDPUR, Sept 24.— Five people, including the Principal of Rajbari Government College, his wife and son received grievous stab and axe injury by a group of masked miscreants at Sajjankanda area in Rajbari town on Thursday night, police said here today, reports UNB.

Police said three youngmen wearing mask and armed with lethal weapons entered the house of Principal Ehiya Islam Chowdhury (53) at Sajjankanda area in the town while the family was watching weekly TV drama "Abar Asiba Fireya" at 9 a.m.

The miscreants hit Principal Ehiya, his wife Rebeya Begum (46), an Associate Professor of Political Science Department of the same college and their son Ripon (18) with knife and Chinese axe indiscriminately.

On hearing their hue and cry, Mukshed (15), a student of class ten of Rajbari Government School and Santu Mollah (40) who was visiting local MP Kazi Keramat Ali's residence, a nextdoor neighbour of the Principal, rushed to the house and also received knife injuries.

All the injured were admitted to Rajbari Sadar Hospital and a mobile OT team including the Civil Surgeon of Faridpur rushed to the spot. They were later shifted to Dhaka for better treatment.

Meanwhile, police picked up three

people for interrogation but motive behind the attack could not be identified immediately.

A case was filed with Rajbari Sadar thana but none was arrested yet.

Police have been deployed in different points of the city including the Principal's house.
