

## Shibir's strike halts RU official work

RAJSHAHI, May 5:—A strike enforced by Islami Chhatra Shibir halted official work and transport on the closed campus of Rajshahi University today, says UNB.

The Shibirites gave the strike call at a sit-in on Tuesday to Press home their demands, including release of their six leaders and arrest of the "killers" of their 12 slain leaders.

The administrative building, including bank, remained closed and no RU bus could ply due to the strike.

The Shibir workers assembled near the main gate of the administrative building at noon, where RU unit Acting President Habibur Rahman, city unit Secretary Mahbubul Ahsan Bulbul and local Shibir leader Abdul Jabbar spoke. Earlier, they brought out a procession on the campus.

Meanwhile, the university authorities banned all sorts of meetings, processions, strike and siege for 18 days from May 8 on the campus and decided to take legal actions against those who would violate the prohibition.

It was also decided that the authorities would not play any role in release of anyone arrested for involvement in terrorist acts.
