DUCSU leaders hail Khaleda's visit to DU

The vice-president and the general secretary of the Dhaka University Central Students Union (DUCSU), Mr Amanullah Aman and Mr. Khairul Kabir Khokon, Thursday welcomed the visit of Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia to the university, reports BSS.

In a joint statement the two DUCSU leaders said after a long gap this was for the first time that a Prime Minister distributed medals to the talents of Dhaka University in the fields of education and research. They described the occasion as "historic and epoch making" in the life of the Dhaka University.

The DUCSU leaders hailed the Prime Minister's announcement at the function regarding construction of a new hall for the girl students, transfer of Atomic Energy Commission premises and Kataban Market area to the Dhaka University besides her assurance to solve various problems of the teachers and employees of the university.

The two leaders expressed the hope that the future heads of elected government would follow the same practice to join such a special function of the Dhaka University to consolidate the tradition of the institution.

They thanked the university authorities for inviting the Prime Minister as the chief guest to the medal distribution function and congratulated the students for welcoming the Prime Minister spontaneously.
