

Varsity teachers to abstain from work today

Teachers of all universities will observe work abstention and bring out silent processions on their respective campuses today (Sunday) in response to the call of the Bangladesh Federation of University Teachers Association (BFTUA).

The BFTUA in a meeting took this decision demanding arrest and trial of those responsible for the attack on Jahangirnagar University teachers and destruction of property.

The Dhaka University Teachers' Association (DUTA) will observe work abstention and bring out procession today (Sunday) in support of BFTUA programme. The procession of DUTA will be brought out from the foot of Aparajeo Bangla at 10 a.m. and concluded near Central Shaheed Minar.

All examinations of the university will remain beyond of the programme, says the DUTA press release.
