JU JCD activists observe token hunger strike

SAVAR, May 15: Jatiyatabadi Chatra Dal of Jahangirnagar University unit today brought out a protest demonstration and later observed a two-hour token hunger strike in front of the Vice-Chancellor's office demanding withdrawal of expulsion orders of two students, reports BSS.

Moazzem Hossain and Yusuf Ali, the two J.C.D. leaders were expelled for one-year for misbehaving with Dr. Golam Hossain, a teacher of Govt. and Politics Department, on December last. Dr Golam Hossain was however removed of his duties for assaulting the Vice-Chancellor of the university early this month.

About 150 activists of JCD today took part in the token hunger strike. Examinees in the Masters examination refused to appear at the final examinations until the expulsion orders were withdrawn. J.C.D. activists will begin "fast-unto-death" tomorrow realise their demand.
