## Call to implement 10-point demand of students

Leaders of Ganotantrik Chhatra Oikya (GCO) at a meeting on Saturday demanded immediate implementation of the ten-point demand of the students.

Addressing the discussion meeting, organised by GCO as part of its Education Day programmes, they blamed the BNP government for what they said hatching out conspiracy to turn the education into commodity and called upon the student community to build united movement against government's "education contraction policy."

The meeting, held on the road island of Dhaka University TSC with Chhatra League (B-K) President Ruhul Kuddus Babu in the chair, was addressed among others by Ragib Ahsan Munna of Chhatra Moitree, Rajekuzzaman Ratan, Samajtantrik Chhatra Front, Ahad Ahmed of Chhatra Federation, Pathik Shaha of Chhatra Union and Humayun Kabir of Chhatra Samity.

They said that the government had betrayed the student community by not accepting the ten-point charter of demands for which the students had sacrificed their blood during the anti-autocratic movement of 1990.
