APSU holds sit-in protest before CU V-C office

CHITTAGONG, Apr. 3:—The All-Party Students Unity (APSU) today held sit-in demonstration in front of the Vice-Chancellor's office of Chittagong University demanding cancellation of B.B.A. admission test question papers.

Several hundred APSU supporters in a procession went to the Vice-Chancellor's office and staged sit-in demonstration for over one hour. They also raised full-throated slogans.

The APSU also held a rally in front of CU CSU building today with student leader Maksudur Rahman in the chair. Among the speakers were Selim Reza Shawrav, Osman Gani Majumdar and Rashedul Alam. They demanded of the university administration for exemplary punishment to those persons who were responsible for leakage of B.B.A. Admission test examination paper. They also demanded annulment of decision of the Syndicate in this respect.

The APSU leaders later met Vice-Chancellor Prof. Rafiqul Islam Chowdhury at his office and presented him with a memorandum in support of their demands.

The Chittagong University Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) also separately held a rally in front of University administrative building today demanding the cancellation of B.B.A. Admission Test question papers.

The rally presided over by University unit JCD President Moynul Ahsan Munna was addressed among others by Mahbubur Rahman Shamim, Kamrul Ahsan Rashed and Arif Akbar Titu.

The Sangrami Chhatra Oikye, an offshoot of the Islami Chhatra Shibir also held a rally and brought out procession on the campus today in protest against recent damage of two university vehicles—including the car of Vice-Chancellor allegedly by pro-AL Chhatra League activists. Presided over by the Oikyo's Joint Convener Shahidullah Majumdar, the rally was addressed by Mohammad Rashed, Miah Mohammad Tawfiqur Rahman and Ruhul Amin.
