## BCL calls indefinite strike in CU

CHITTAGONG, June 24:—  
Bangladesh Chhatra League has called for an indefinite strike in Chittagong University from tomorrow (Saturday) to protest Thursday's attack on its activists by Shibir supporters, reports UNB.

Five BCL activists were injured in a clash with Islami Chhatra Shibir workers on Thursday following altercations over the Supreme Court verdict restoring the citizenship of Jamaat leader Golam Azam.

The condition of two injured BCL activists Selim and Heru deteriorated today and they were admitted to a private clinic.

Vice Chancellor of the University Prof Rafiqul Islam Chowdhury visited the injured students at the clinic and enquired about their treatment.

The VC's planned meeting with the student organisations to ease the situation arising out to Thursday's incident could not be held today as BCL leaders refused to attend it. Prof Islam, however, hoped that the meeting could take place any time.
