BCL (M-I) call to make tomorrow's strike a success

The Bangladesh Chhatra League (M-I) on Friday threatened tough action against the Dhaka University authorities if the April 12 DUCSU and hall students' union election are not deferred by March 27.

The leaders of the pro-Awami League backed Chhatra League (M-I) announced a two-day strike programme on April 11 and 12 in Dhaka University demanding resignation of the University V-C Prof. Emajuddin Ahamed.

Announcing the programmes at a demonstration staged in front of the Dhaka University V-C's residence on Friday evening Chhatra League leaders accused Prof. Emajuddin Ahamed of providing shelter to a terrorist group of Government backed student organisation.

The two-hour long demonstration in front of the V-C's residence was addressed by a number of Chhatra League leaders including central president Moinuddin Hasan Chowdhury, General Secretary Iqbalur Rahim, DU unit General Secretary Pankaj Devanath and city (north) unit President Manjurul Islam Asru.

Chhatra league leaders urged the university students to make its tomorrow's (Sunday) strike in the university a success.

Chhatra Okiya Parishad (COP), a newly formed alliance of the seven student organisations, at a meeting on Friday decided to boycott the

ensuing DUCSU and hall students union elections due to the absence of congenial atmosphere on the campus.

The COP at the meeting decided to hold a rally at the foot of Aparajeo Bangla on March 28 at 11 a.m.

Changes in polls schedule

Meanwhile, the DUCSU election advisory council at a meeting on Friday evening has brought some change in the election schedule of April 12.

According to a University Press release, the final voter list will be available on March 28 at 4 p.m. Nomination papers will be available at 11 a.m. till March 29 and the DUCSU returning officers will receive the nomination papers on the same day from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. at any halls and then they (returning officers) will send the nomination papers to the Chief Returning Officer at the V-C's office at 3 p.m. The final scrutiny will be made also on the same day from 3 p.m. at V-C's office and all DUCSU returning officers will be present there with the final voter list.

The draft list of the candidates will be announced at 4 p.m. on March 30 and withdrawal of candidature on April 3 by 12 noon. The final list of candidates will be announced at 4 p.m. on April 4.
