JCD's call to resist Jamaat-Shibir axis

Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal on Monday urged all progressive student organisations to build united resistance against the killer Jamaat-Shibir axis whom it termed enemy of democracy and development, reports UNB.

Addressing a student gathering on the Dhaka University campus to protest Sunday's killing of two JCD men in Chittagong, the leaders of the student front of ruling BNP also asked JCD activists to resist the "anti-liberation" elements.

The JCD Central Committee held the protest rally in front of Aparajco Bangla at 11:30 demanding arrest and trial of the killers of Jamiruddin and Jahangir Farid.

The two JCD leaders were

gunned down at Chittagong Polytechnic Institute allegedly by a group of Shibir activists.

Chhatra Dal President Fazlul Haq Milan gave the Home Ministry 24 hours to arrest the "killers" alongwith arms. "Otherwise, the authorities will be responsible for any circumstances," he warned.

While urging all student organisations to start a resistance movement under the leadership of DUCSU, JCD General Secretary Nazimuddin Alam criticised Awami League for its "alliance" with Jamaat-e-Islami. He was also critical about its student organisation, Chhatra League, for not condemning Sunday's killings.

"We have shown too much patience and held many protest rallies against Jamaat-Shibir," Alam said, adding no more protest rally, we will now take revenge for any killing."
