

BCL activist killed at DU

Imam Hossain Tonoy, an outsider was assassinated on Dhaka University campus in the early hours of Thursday.

He was the Assistant Library Secretary of Dhaka City (North) unit of Bangladesh Chhatra League, student front of the ruling party.

Police recovered Tonoy's body from Fazlul Haque Hall premises on Thursday morning and took it to Dhaka Medical College Hospital for autopsy.

His face and other parts of the body was almost minced by sharp weapons.

Some residents of Fazlul Haque Hall said that a group of assailants went to the hall gate in two micro-buses at about 4 a.m. Some of the assailants went to room number 201 and took him out of the hall. Later his body was found dumped near the eastern gate of Curzon Hall.

Hailing from Shariyetpur Sadar thana area, Tonoy was youngest among his three brothers.

Some students of Fazlul Haque Hall, who did not want to be quoted,

said that old conflict might be the reason behind the killing.

A case has been registered with Ramna police station. No arrest has so far been made.

Meanwhile, Chhatra League brought out a mourning procession in the city carrying Tonoy's body in the afternoon. They protested the killing and demanded arrest and trial of the killers.

Muktijoddah Shishu Kishore Command held an emergency meeting at its office in the afternoon. The meeting condemned the killing and demanded arrest and trial of the killers. The Shishu Kishore Command will stage a sit-in demonstration in front of the Home Ministry to press home their demand for arrest and trial of Tonoy's killers on July 15.

Tonoy's body has been sent to his village home at Shariyetpur in the evening after autopsy and other formalities.
