BCL leader held with arms from DU hall gate

Police caught a Bangladesh Chhatra League (S-P) activist redhanded with a cut rifle and ten rounds of bullets from the gate of a hall of Dhaka University on Sunday midnight.

Campus sources said, the Detective Branch (DB) police acting on a tip caught the BCL activist Abdul Khalaq on Sunday midnight. They were guarding at the Mohsin Hall gate.

Khaleq, a third year Honours student of Islamic History and Culture Department of the university was an activist of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) prior to capturing of Mohsin Hall by the BCL members.

BCL rally

The ruling party's student front Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) at a rally on Sunday said that a vested quarter was conspiring to create unrest on Dhaka University campus.

Addressing a rally held at the Aparajeyo Bangla of the university the BCL leaders said any kind of conspiracy to make the campus violent would be resisted by the Chhatra League workers.

The BCL leaders also said that there was no place for terrorists in Bangladesh Chhatra League. They demanded immediate arrest of all the terrorists, irrespective of party affiliations.

The rally was addressed by BCL President, Enamul Haq Shamim, General Secretary Ishaq Ali Khan Panna, Bahadur Beparty and Abul Woadud Khokon.

Earlier, they brought out a procession on the Dhaka University campus.
