DUCSU slates police attack on JCD activists

DUCSU has strongly condemned police attack on Chhatra Dal activists in the name of raid and protested the terrorism unleashed on the campus by 'joint forces of Awami League and the police', reports UNB.

VP Amanullah Aman MP and General Secretary Khairul Kabir Khokan in a statement on Saturday said three activists of BCL attacked and injured Apel, a JCD worker, on Wednesday as he came to the campus to submit admission form of her sister.

They also assaulted his sister during this attack, they said.

The BCL activists opened fired on a peaceful procession of JCD protesting the incident.

At one stage, they forcibly entered into Surya Sen Hall with the help of police. JCD and other legal residents of the dormitory protested the incident, they said.

On Thursday, police unleashed brutal attack on JCD workers in Jasimuddin, Ziaur Rahman and Bangabandhu halls and arrested a number of them. They also helped the armed terrorists to capture the halls.

The DUCSU leaders held Vice Chancellor Prof AK Azad Chowdhury responsible for the attacks on JCD workers.

They demanded immediate release of the arrested JCD workers and arrest of BCL terrorists involved in the incident.
