2,326 SSC examinees expelled

A total of 2326 Secondary School Certificate (SSC) examinees were expelled from different centres under four education boards of the country on Monday for adopting unfair means.

A total of 510 examinees were expelled from different centres of the Dhaka Board, 531 under Comilla Board, 909 under Rajshahi Board and 376 under Jessore Board.

Seven examinees were expelled in Dhaka City, 33 in Gazipur, 14 in Narayanganj, 22 in Narsingdi, 20 in Munshiganj, 8 in Manikganj, 62 in Tangail, 20 in Faridpur, 41 in Madaripur, 10 in Shariatpur, 22 in Rajbari, 8 in Gopalganj, 98 in Mymensingh, 49 in Kishoreganj, 45 in Netrakona, 30 in Jamalpur and 21 in Sherpur, according to Dhaka Board control room.

43 candidates fail to appear at exam

UNB from Jamalpur adds: The students, teachers and guardians of Nandipa Nek Jahan Girls High School at a Press conference accused the Chairman and Controller of Dhaka Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Board for not complying the directives of the High Court.

In the Press conference held at the residence of former MP Shafiqul Islam Khoka at Station Road on May 3 the acting Headmaster of the school Atiar Rahman said the Controller of the Board deliberately did not supply forms for the SSC candidates of the school though the time for filling up the form for this year's SSC examination has already expired. As a result, 43 SSC candidates of the school could not appear at the examination.
