The results of the SSC examinations held under four education boards of the country this year is expected to be published by the end of this month, reports Media Syndicate.

University of Engineering and Technology (BUET) entrusted with processing the final results is processing them and will start tabulation as soon as they get signal from the Ministry of Education.

Sources said, under an agreement with the concerned authorities, BUET was to be given all answer sheets, after marking by July 31. And the Computer Centre was to prepare the results within the third week of this month. But that has not been possible as yet. Every year 1 or 2 per cent scripts stay with the examiners which causes the delay in their publication. If the examination scripts are submitted and signal received in time, it will be possible to prepare the results in time. Chairman of Dhaka Board, Prof. M Latisur Rahman is optimistic of publishing the results within this month. Computerised system was first introduced in the SSC examinations this year code numbers instead of roll numbers have been used to ensure strict neutrality in marking.

About 6,83,668 candidates sat for the SSC examination under the four boards this year.
