7.9 lakh students appear at SSC examination tomorrow

The Secondary School Certificate (SSC) examinations, 1995, under four education boards of the country will begin tomorrow (Thursday).

A total of 7 lakh 89 thousand students will appear at 754 centres in this year's SSC examinations under four education boards.

Under the Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education (BISE), Dhaka a total of 2,40,000 students will appear at 199 examinations centres, under BISE, Comilla, 1,90,000 students at 212 centres, under BISE, Rajshahi, 1,98,000 students at 188 centres and under BISE, Jessore, 1,60,000 students appear at 155 centres.

Meanwhile, authorities of

four education boards have completed all preparations for holding the examination smoothly. All possible measures would be taken to maintain law and order in and round all examination centres and stop unfair means in examination halls, according to an official source. Special care has been taken so that teachers of a school under no circumstances are appointed invigilators in examination centre where students of the same school will be appearing. Besides, every student will be searched bodily for illegal papers before his or her entry into the examination

hall or room.

The Education Secretary by a public notification warned that violators of law order at the examination centres would be tried on the spot under public examinations (offences) act.

Meanwhile, the Dhaka Metropolitan police has banned assembly and movement of more than four persons together within 200 yards of the centres of SSC examinations. The ban will remain in force from April 20 to May 21 around 95 examination centres in the capital to ensure proper and peaceful conduct of the examinations.
