BCTA concerned over attack on exam invigilators

The President of Bangladesh College Teachers' Association (BCTA) AKM Zahirul Islam and the General Secretary Kazi Faruq Ahmed in a joint statement on Wednesday expressed resentment and concern at the attack on invigilators and other officials by violent elements at different HSC examination centres and demanded adequate security measures for invigilators at examination centres.

In the statement the BCTA leaders said that violent elements attacked invigilators and other officials on duty at the Kaliganj High School Centre during English first paper examination on July 10 that left a teacher Shafiuddin Ahmed injured.

They demanded stern measures against those responsible for assaulting teachers and creating trouble at examination centres.
