

Dhaka 49.97, Comilla 61.18, Ctg 61.37, Rajshahi 49.16, Jessore 47.45

The results of Secondary School Certificates (SSC) examinations held in March-April this year under five education boards of the country were published on Wednesday.

The percentage of pass in Dhaka Board is 49.97, Rajshahi Board 49.16, Comilla Board 61.18, Jessore Board 47.45 and Chittagong Board 61.37.

The average percentage of pass of all five boards is 53.82.

The groupwise percentage of pass under Dhaka Board is 66.48 in science and 36.16 in social science, under

Rajshahi Board 70.66 in science and 39.43 in social science, under Comilla Board 75.92 in science and 48.73 in social science, under Jessore Board 70.75 in science and 38.81 in social science and under Chittagong Board 77.49 in science and 50.22 in social science.

Under Dhaka Board, the highest number of students appeared in the examinations and passed followed by the students of Rajshahi Board.

A total of 2,15,604 students sat for examinations under Dhaka Board, of whom 1,07,730 came out successful,

of the successful students, 40,702 got first division, 64,379 second division and 2,649 third division.

While, a total of 1,83,345 candidates appeared in the examinations under Rajshahi Board, of whom 90,135 came out successful. Of the total successful candidates, 27,193

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got first division, 59,460 second division and 3,482 third division.

A total of 1,19,472 students sat for examinations under Comilla Board, of whom 73,090 came out successful.

Of the successful students, 27,171 got first division, 44,353 second division and 1,566 third division.

Under Jessore Board a total of 1,36,129 candidates appeared in the examinations, of whom 64,587 came out successful. Of the successful candidates, 20,939 got first division, 41,948 second division and 1,700 third division.

In all 62,315 students sat for examinations under Chittagong Board, of whom 38,242 came out successful.

Of the successful students, 12,754 got first division, 24,202 second division and 1,286 third division.

A total of 93,971 female students

appeared in the examinations under Dhaka Board, of whom 43,370 came out successful. Of the successful female students, 13,980 got first division, 27,981 second division and 1,409 third division.

In all 72,469 female candidates appeared in the examinations under Rajshahi Board, of whom 34,332 came out successful. Of the successful female candidates, 8,132 got first division, 24,518 second division and 1,682 third division.

A total of 53,436 female students sat for examinations under Comilla Board, of whom 30,675 came out successful. Of the total successful

female students, 9,009 got first division, 20,664 second division and 1,002 third division.

Under Jessore Board, a total of 55,554 female candidates appeared in the examinations, of whom 24,581 came out successful. Of the successful female candidates 6,234 got first division, 17,403 second division and 944 third division.

A total of 28,394 female students sat for examinations under Chittagong Board, of whom 16,805 came out successful. Of the successful female students, 4,893 got first division, 11,212 second division and 700 third division.

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
