2407 SSC examinees expelled on 2nd day

Some 2,407 examinees were expelled from different centres of the country for adopting unfair means on the second day of the SSC examination Saturday, reports UNB.

Official sources said 902 candidates were expelled under Dhaka Board, 358 under Jessore Board, 108 under Comilla Board, 87 under Chittagong Board and 952 under Rajshahi Board during the examination of the English second paper.

Under Dhaka Board, 71 students were expelled in Jamalpur, 66 in Munshiganj, 5 in Dhaka, 91 in Nar-

shingdi, 22 in Rajbari, 28 in Gopalganj, 236 in Netrokona, 61 in Sherpur, 39 in Mymensingh, 67 in Manikganj, 16 in Narayanganj, 210 in Tangail, 67 in Faridpur and 69 in Madaripur.

In Jessore Board, one in Satkhira, 18 in Bhola, 12 in Khulna, 7 in Bagerhat, 19 in Pirojpur, 40 in Jessore, 26 in Patuakhali, 25 in Borgona, 30 in Zalakhati, 5 in Norail, 9 in Magura, 35 in Jenaidha, 17 in Chuadanga, 108 in Kushtia and 2 in Barisal.

According to available statistics, 73 were expelled in Comilla district and 73 in Noakhali under the Comilla Board.

In Chittagong Board, the number of expelled students was 87 in Chittagong city.

Under Rajshahi Board, 115 were expelled in Naogaon, 122 in Nilphamari, 94 in Pabna, 106 in Gaibandha, 122 in Rangpur, 78 in Chapainawabganj, 61 in Joypurhat, 131 in Rajshahi, 110 in Sirajganj, 78 in Nawabganj and 35 in Lalmonirhat.
