

## 68.88 pc pass Dakhil exam

The results of Dakhil examination (equivalent to SSC) held under the Madrasah Board in April 1998, were announced on Thursday.

A total of 1,34,856 examinees, including 39,054 female students, appeared in the examination this year. Of them 87,499 came out successful.

The pass percentage is 68.88.

Of the 87,499 successful examinees, 21,358 got first division, 60,057 second division and 6,084 third division.

In general group, a total of 1,22,014 students, including 37,247 female examinees, appeared in the examination, of them 78,224 passed. Of the successful candidates, 16,671 secured first division, 55,598 second division while 5955 third divisions.

The percentage of pass in this group is 64.11.

A total of 11,902 examinees, including 1,640 girls, appeared in the

examination from science group, of them 8,771 came out successful. In this group 4566 students secured first division, 4,051 second division while 114 third division.

The percentage of pass in this group is 73.36.

A total of 926 students, including 167 females, appeared in the examination from Mujabbid group and 534 students passed. Of the successful students, 117 got first division, 401 second division while 15 third division.

The pass percentage in this group is 57.67.

In Hifjul Quran group, a total of 14 students appeared in the examination. Of them 10 came out successful, 4 students got first division and 6 second division.

The pass percentage in this group is 72.43.

Muhammad Anisur Rahman of Faridganj Majidia Alia Madrasah, Chandpur (bearing roll No. 11181) topped the combined merit list of the four groups. He appeared in the examination from science group and secured 891 marks.

Mohammad Shafiqul Islam of Dhamati Islamia Alia Madrasah, Comilla (science group roll No. 10657) and Mohammad Saiful Islam Khondaker of Chhagalniya Islamia Fazil Madrasah, Feni (general group roll No. 148860) jointly secured the second position securing 879 marks both.

Mohammad Delwar Hossain of Dhamati Islamia Alia Madrasah, Comilla (science group roll No. 10658) obtained third position in the combined merit list bagging 864 marks.

Rashida of Gopalganj Mahila Dakhil Madrasah, Gopalganj (bearing roll No. M-13223) stood first in the combined merit list of female group. She got 852 marks.
