## Notice For Admission in Dental College

1. Applications are invited in prescribed form for Admission into the 1st year B.D.S. class of Dental College, Dacca for the session 1981-82.
2. The candidate must be a Bangladeshi National and must have passed SSC & HSC Examinations at least in the 2nd Division with Chemistry, Physics, Biology or its equivalent recognised by the Boards of Intermediate and Secondary Education or Universities of Bangladesh and must have obtained at least 60% marks (without grace marks and after deduction for irregularity) in the combined total of SSC & HSC marks in order to be eligible for admission.
3. Candidates who passed HSC Examination in the current calendar year i.e. 1981 and passed SSC Examination 2 years back i.e. 1979 in due time, will be considered as regular. A candidate who has passed SSC Examination prior to 1979 will be considered as irregular and for each year of irregularity, 25 marks will be deducted from the total of HSC marks. Improvement examination will be considered as irregular.
4. Total number of seats in Dacca Dental College will be as follows:—
 

For Bangladeshi Nationals	— 55
For Foreign Nationals	— 5

5. 30% of the seats may be taken from female candidates on the basis of merits amongst themselves, if available. If not available seats shall go to the male students on the basis of merit amongst themselves.
6. 2 seats, to be kept reserved for sons and daughters of Bangladeshi dentists, on the basis of merit amongst them.
7. 2 seats are kept reserved for para Medical students having at least 2nd Division in both SSC & HSC. In their case, marks will not be deducted for loss of Years of irregularity.
8. 1 seat is reserved for persons of tribal origin but the candidate must have at least 2nd Division in both SSC & HSC (Sylhet & Chittagong), 25 marks will be deducted from the total marks obtained in SSC & HSC Examination for each year of irregularity.
9. Results of SSC & HSC Examinations shall be verified before admission. The students shall be provisionally admitted. They shall be finally admitted or rejected after verification of the results from the boards.
10. The results of the viva-voce will be put up on the notice board every day and a copy of the same will be forwarded to the Director, Medical Education & Hospitals on the same day.
11. Students will be admitted in the Dental College on the basis of merit.
12. A cash payment of Tk. 10/- (ten) will have to be made as registration fee at the time of obtaining the application form. Those who would like to receive application forms by post should send a stamped self-addressed envelope and a Crossed Cheque of Tk. 10/- (ten) in favour of the principal, Dental College Dacca.
13. The foreign students must apply through their respective Governments and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Govt. of Bangladesh and must have passed the SSC or its equivalent examination and the HSC or its equivalent examination with Biology, Physics and Chemistry in the HSC provided such equivalent examinations are recognised by the Government of Bangladesh.
14. Foreign students are to be admitted on payment of usual charges plus U.S. \$ 1000/- per annum as tuition fees and other fees unless they are given scholarship by Bangladesh Government. Foreign students who are admitted on Bangladesh Scholarship on the basis of bilateral agreement are to be indicated by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs with a mention as to whether they are to pay tuition fees or not.
15. Viva-voce test will be held for all eligible candidates in the College. Results of the viva-voce test will be published on the same dates. A written test, with a code number for each candidate will be conducted and all the marks obtained in viva voce and written test will be added to marks obtained on the basis of results of SSC and HSC. Written scripts should be checked and numbers allotted in a single session with participation of all examinees on same day.
16. At the time of submission of application of Tk. 35/- (Thirty five) will be payable in cash as centre fee. Those who will like to send their applications by post should enclose a crossed cheque of Tk. 35/- (Thirty five) payable to the principal, Dacca Dental College. This amount is not refundable.
17. Final selection of a candidate is subject to medical fitness.
18. All certificates/documents in original are to be submitted at the time of admission on failing which applicant's candidature will be rejected.
19. Completed application in the prescribed form is to be submitted accompanied by the following documents:—
  - a) Attested copies of SSC and HSC certificates or testimonials.
  - b) Attested copies of SSC and HSC mark-sheets.
  - c) Attested copy of certificates from the head of the Institution in which the applicant studied last regarding his/her character/personality career and extra-curriculum activities.
  - d) Certificate of character from a Class I Gazetted Officer.
  - e) Attested copy of nationality certificate.
  - f) Attested copy of certificate from a Class I Gazetted Officer or of father/guardian or an attested copy of the income tax certificate.
  - g) Certificate from a Class —I Gazetted or Chairman of Union Council stating the name of the district of which the candidate is a permanent resident.
  - h) In case of sons/daughters of Dentist who have applied for reserved seats, a declaration in the prescribed manner in the handwriting of the Dentist parent will have to be submitted along with the application.
  - i) Attested copy of the Registration Certificate (of Bangladesh Medical and Dental Council) of Dentist parent of candidates who have applied for reserved seats.
  - j) Three attested copies of passport size photograph of the candidates.
  - k) Receipt of registration fee for Tk. 10/- (ten) only.
20. Applications received after the expiry of the target date and time and incomplete applications will not be considered.
21. All information regarding admission will be found on the notice boards of the Dental College. No correspondence in connection with admission will be made at the address of the candidates.
22. Last date for receipt of application is 31-10-1981 up to 1.00 p.m.
23. Further information regarding admission matter will be available in the Office of Dacca Dental College.
