Announcement for admission to M. Phil.
/Ph.D. degree course in 1981-82.

IBS offers some fellowships valued each at Tk. 700/00 per month tenable for two years' full-time course and dissertation work leading to M. Phil. degree and a few at the rate of Tk. 750/00 per month tenable for three years' full-time course and dissertation work leading to Ph.D. degree at the Institute. Two fellowships will be kept reserved for woman candidates, if found suitable.

Candidates must have Master's degree in any field of Social Sciences and Humanities, such as Economics, Agri-Economics, Sociology, Political Science, Public Administration, Geography, History, Islamic History and Culture, Social Psychology, Social Anthropology, Statistics, Demography, Communications, Social Work, Bengali, Comparative Literature, Comparative Philology, Linguistics, Law, Accounting, Management and Finance. Candidates must have good academic records with at least 50% marks at the Bachelor and Master's examination.

Every successful candidate on admission has to sign a bond pledging to continue through the end of the degree programme.

Applications in plain paper should include the following: (1) Name, (2) Father's name, (3) Mailing address, (4) Permanent address, (5) Marital Status, (6) Home District, (7) Date of Birth, (8) Educational Qualifications from S.S.C. upward, Institutions attended, certificate/degree with year, subject, Division/Class and marks obtained, (9) Other Qualifications, experience in support of candidature, (10) A short statement of research interest, specifying the field and problem, (11) Attested copies of certificates, diplomas and mark-sheets (from S.S.C. to Master's degree) and (12) Bank Draft of Tk. 10/00 (ten) in favour of the Secretary, IBS.

Applications with photo should reach the undersigned on or before 8 June, 1981. Incomplete applications will not be entertained.

Eligible candidates shall be called for written and oral test at the Institute on June 23-24. Exact dates will, however, be communicated to them individually. Admission of successful candidates will take place between 25-30 June 1981 and classes will commence on 1 July, 1981.
