

## Admission Notice

First Year Honours : Academic Session 1981-82

Applications are invited for admission to three-year Honours course of Arts/Science/Commerce Faculty and four-year Honours course of Law Faculty.

## 1. Minimum qualification for submission of applications for admission :

A) Should have 2nd division in both Secondary Certificate and Higher Secondary Certificate examinations and secure 40% marks in the subject to be read in Honours course. or if the subject to be read in Honours course was not included at Higher Secondary level then 40% marks in the relevant subject in the Higher Secondary Certificate examination.

OR

B) In case of 3rd Division in Secondary Certificate examination and 2nd Division in Higher Secondary Certificate examination 45% marks should have been secured in the subject to be read in the lower course or if the subject to be read in the Honours course was not included at Higher Secondary level 45% marks in the relevant subject in the Higher Secondary Certificate examination.

OR

C) In case of 2nd Division in Secondary Certificate examination and 3rd Division in Higher Secondary Certificate examination 50% marks should have been secured in the subject to be read in Honours course or if the subject to be read in Honours course was not included at Higher Secondary level than 50% marks in the relevant subject in the Higher Secondary Certificate examination.

D) In case of candidates who have passed the Diploma in Commerce must have 2nd Division in both Secondary Certificate and Higher Secondary Certificate examinations for admission to 1st year Honours Commerce Department.

E) Students (male/female) who passed in any group of Higher Secondary Certificate examination are eligible to apply for admission to Honours course of Law Faculty subject to the fulfilment of the terms and conditions mentioned at A, B, C, and D.

F) In case of sportsman/artist/tribal/aborigin/husband, wife, sons and daughters and own brother and sister, 2nd Division in any one of Secondary and Higher Secondary Certificate examinations.

G) Students (male/female) only who have passed Higher Secondary Certificate examination in the year 1979, 1980 and 1981 are eligible to apply for admission to 1st year Honours course.

H) Candidates who have passed both Secondary and Higher Secondary Certificate examinations in 3rd Division are not eligible for admission to Honours courses.

I) Students (male/female) whose admission have been cancelled recently cannot submit application for admission.

J) Students (male/female) of Higher Secondary Science group for admission to Arts Faculty/Commerce Faculty and students (male/female) of Higher Secondary Commerce group for admission to Arts Faculty and students (male/female) of Higher Secondary Arts group for admission to Commerce Faculty must have 2nd Division both in Secondary and Higher Secondary examinations. But in case of admission to English and Bengali this condition is not applicable.

2. The terms and conditions of decision mentioned at serial No. 1 are equally applicable in case of Colleges under the affiliation of the University.

No College can give admission to anybody violating above mentioned terms and conditions.

3. Application of sportsmen and artists will have to be submitted to the office of the Physical Training Education Department and office of the Deputy Registrar (Academic).

Applications for admission as aboriginal/tribal/husband, wife, sons, daughters, own brother and sister of the employee of this University will have to be submitted to Department concerned.

4. The quota for admission to different honours courses in the affiliated Colleges has been fixed by the University and Colleges also notified the same and to exceed the fixed quota will not be allowed.

The number of students (male/female) for admission to different Honours course in affiliated Colleges as sportsmen or artists should not be above 2% of total admitted students.

5. Last date of submitting application to the Department is 5th December '81.

6. Admission test in the Department will be started between 8th December and 19th December '81.

7. (a) Admission to Hons/Pass course will start from 21st December '81.

(b) Without late fee of Taka 5/- 4th January '82.

(c) With late fee of Taka 5/- 21st January '82.

D) Class will commence from 21st January '82.

8. Taka 5/- (Taka five) for application form of admission for each Department will have to be deposited through Bank Draft crossed in favour of the Registrar of Rajshahi University or will have to be deposited through

Miscellaneous release receipt with the Agrani Bank branch at University.

9. Application form for admission may be had from the Academic Section after depositing fee for same admission test. Admit card will have to be collected from the Department concerned where admission test will be held.

10. Original admission form will be supplied to the selected students (male/female) only from the Department.

The following documents will have to be produced at the time of admission.

1. Original certificate of School Secondary Certificate examination passed or Original Marksheet issued by Education Board.

2. Original Marksheet of Higher Secondary Certificate examination passed issued by the Education Board.

3. Testimonials issued by the College Authority.

4. Passport size photo (for original admission form).

12. Students (male/female) selected for admission will have to submit original admission form duly filled in to the office of the Department, scrutinised and recommended form by the Chairman of Department will have to be sent to the Departmental office at Residential Hall mentioned in the form. After scrutiny and recommendation by the Provost the Residential Hall office will send the admission form to Academic Section. Incomplete admission form without attested true copies of original certificates will not be accepted. All original certificates will have to be produced to the Academic Section for signature by the Registrar. No student (male/female) without original certificate will be given admission.

13. Students (male/female) will have to collect the date, time, place of test/viva voce for admission from the Department at their own responsibility.
