



World's most valuable stamp!

LONDON: Watchful eyes on the world's most valuable stamp. The unique one cent British Guiana 1856 magenta, the world's most valuable postage stamp, under close scrutiny by Mr Howard Trauer, Chairman of the Stanley

Gibbon Gallery in London's Strand where it was on show recently. The stamp was originally discovered by an English schoolboy in Demerara, British Guiana, who sold it for six shillings. It fetched 280,000 US dollars the last

time it changed hands and it will be auctioned again in New York this month. Which explains why the close scrutiny of the stamp's destiny extended to the security guard specially contracted to watch over it!
