AIT Scholarship for May term 1984

Applications are invited from qualified candidates who are bonafide citizens of Bangladesh for the Asian Institute of Technology Scholarship for post-graduate course leading to the degree of Master of Engineering or Master of Science beginning in May, 1984. Master's degree course normally takes 20 months.

2. These scholarships are tenable at the Asian Institute of Technology situated in Bangkok, Thailand. The Institute is an autonomous International Board of Trustees with students from about 20 countries in Asia. The Scholarship includes subsistence allowance, tuition fees & text books, one-way or round trip travel is also provided.

3. The following fields of study are available for May, 1984 term. The applicants will be interviewed on the dates and time mentioned against the subjects by an Interview Board appointed by the Government.

4. Applicants will be required to take a written examination for about an hour on their chosen subject of study and on English. The date and time for this written examination will be notified to them at the time of interview.

The candidates will have to submit their applications in the prescribed application forms which are available in the office of Dr. Abdul Hannan, Dean, Faculty of Civil Engineering, Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology, Dhaka. Photostat/attested copies of certificates, testimonials, marksheets etc. must be submitted alongwith the application.

6. Departmental candidates must apply through proper channel.

7. None with third division in any public examination need apply.

8. The closing date for submission of application is January 3, 1984. Application should be submitted in the office of the Dean as mentioned above.
