Admission Notice

Applications in prescribed forms are invited from students who passed their H.S.C. examinations in 1984 for admission into First Year Classes of 4 (four) years long following different courses of the Bangladesh Agricultural University in the 1984-85 academic session.

1. Bachelor of Agriculture (Honours).
2. Bachelor of Veterinary (D.V.M).
3. Bachelor of Animal Husbandry (Honours).
4. Bachelor of Agricultural Economics (Honours).
5. Bachelor of Agricultural Engineering (Honours).
6. Bachelor of Fisheries (Honours).

Students seeking admission must have passed in Science Group Secondary School Certificate and Higher Secondary Certificate or equivalent examinations securing at least 2nd Division in each from any Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Board of Bangladesh obtaining at least 55 (fifty five) per cent marks jointly in both the examinations. Those students who have passed Secondary and Higher Secondary examinations before 1981 and 1983 respectively are not eligible to apply, and those who have passed School Certificate examination in 1981 will be considered as irregular candidates and 25 marks will be deducted from their total obtained marks (excepting grace marks) in both the examinations.

Courses	Subjects to be read
a) Bachelor of Agriculture (Honours) and Bachelor of Animal Husbandry (Hons).	Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and/or Biology
b) Bachelor of Ag. Engineering (Hons). and Bachelor of Ag. Economics (Honours)	Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics.
c) Bachelor of Fisheries (Honours) and Bachelor of Veterinary (D.V.M)	Physics, Chemistry, Biology.

The prescribed admission form duly filled in along with attested copies of necessary documents, certificates of related examinations (if obtained) and marksheet, character certificate from the head of the institute the candidate last attended and three recently taken passport-size photographs, must reach the Dean Office of concerned Departments positively by 26th May, 1985 (Sunday). Incomplete, irregular and illegible applications will be treated as directly rejected.

Applications received for admission into the different courses will be primarily scrutinized on the basis of marks obtained in the Secondary and Higher Secondary or equivalent examinations. On the basis of scrutinized applications candidates have to sit for admission test to be held for selection. Necessary information about admission test will be informed through newspapers.

Written selective examinations will be held on the subjects mentioned in the above form against related courses as per syllabus of Higher Secondary examinations and, in addition, language subjects for Agricultural Economics and Rural Social Science Departments. For attending the selective examinations candidates will not be paid any conveyance allowance from this University and for their fooding and lodging the University will have no responsibility. During 1984-85 academic session (a) there is no possibility of resuming classes before July, 1985, (b) Seat arrangement for the admitted students in the Halls cannot be ensured due to paucity of the same. A limited number of students may be allowed stipend on merit basis from the University.

Each copy of admission form and prospectus can be obtained on payment of Tk. 15 (fifteen) and Tk. 10 (ten) respectively from the branches of Public Bank at different district headquarters and from the branch situated at the Bangladesh Agricultural University campus.
