

Admission Notice: Academic Session—1986-87

Applications in prescribed form are hereby invited for 'Admission Test' examinations for admission into the first year degree classes of all the Faculties of this University for the academic session 1986-87

**FACULTIES OF ENGINEERING, CIVIL ENGINEERING, MECHANICAL
ENGINEERING, AND ELECTRICAL & ELECTRONIC ENGINEERING.**

ELIGIBILITY FOR SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION TEST

1. Candidates must be citizens of Bangladesh either by birth or by domicile.
2. Only those candidates who have passed H.S.C. examination or its equivalent not earlier than the calendar year 1985. Subject to fulfilment of the conditions 3 & 4 as under, are eligible to apply.
3. Candidates must have passed S.S.C. examination of any Education Board of Bangladesh or its equivalent and obtained at least 50% marks on the average or equivalent grades.
4. Candidates must have passed H.S.C. examination of any Education Board of Bangladesh or its equivalent and obtained at least 65% marks on the average in the subjects of Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry and a minimum of 50% marks in each of these three subjects separately or equivalent grades in these subjects.
5. A merit list on the basis of the marks of Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry only of the H.S.C. examination or the equivalent grades in these subjects will be prepared out of which only the first three thousand and five hundred candidates will be allowed to take part in the Admission Test examination. All the candidates in the three thousand five hundred position having equal marks will also be allowed to take part in the Admission Test Examination.

Subjects of Admission Test Examination :

The Admission Test examination will be held in the subjects of Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry only on the basis of the syllabuses of H.S.C. examinations conducted by the different Boards of Bangladesh in 1986. In order to test the suitability of the candidates some questions basic and elementary nature on the subjects may also be set.

Number of Seats and Procedure of Selection :

The maximum total number of seats in the first year B.Sc. Engineering degree course in the Faculties of Engineering, Civil Engineering, Mechanical Engineering and Electrical & Electronic Engineering is 510 of which 3 seats are reserved for the candidates from Chittagong Hill Tracts and other Tribal Areas of Bangladesh. Candidates from Tribal Areas must submit certificates from the Principal of the College from which they passed H.S.C. examination or First Class Gazetted Officer or the Chairman of local Union Parishad to bear out their claim for these reserved seats and **must indicate in the Application Form that they belong to Tribal Area**. Candidates for these reserved seats must fulfil the minimum qualification requirements and must get the minimum qualifying marks in the Admission Test examination.

A merit list will be prepared on the basis only of the marks obtained in Mathematics Physics and Chemistry in the Admission Test examination. A candidate who will secure less than 200 marks out of 600 marks in the Admission Test examination will not be considered eligible for admission. In case of tie in the Admission Test examination result, merit position will be determined on the basis of higher marks obtained in Mathematics. Marks obtained in Physics will be considered next.

Departmentwise Distribution of Seats & Option for Departments :

The 510 seats for B.Sc. Engineering degree course of four years duration will be distributed in the different departments as showed

Candidates must give option in the Application Form, in order of their preference, for all the departments listed above. Department-wise list of successful candidates, based on their option and their merit position in the Admission Test examination will be published.

Faculty of Architecture & Planning.

Eligibility for Admission Test :

1. Candidates must be citizens of Bangladesh either by birth or by domicile.
2. Only those candidates who have passed H.S.C. examination or its equivalent not earlier than the calendar year 1985 subject to fulfilment of the conditions (3) & (4) as under are eligible to apply.
3. Candidates must have passed S.S.C. examination of any Education Board of Bangladesh or its equivalent at least in Second Division securing minimum 50% marks excluding marks of additional subjects.
4. Candidates must have passed H.S.C. examination of any Education Board of Bangladesh or its equivalent at least in Second Division securing at least pass mark in Mathematics and minimum 50% marks excluding marks of additional subjects.

5. A merit list on the basis of the marks obtained in H.S.C. examinations (excluding marks of additional subjects) or its equivalent will be prepared out of which only the first three thousand candidates will be allowed to take part in the Admission Test examination. All the candidates in the three thousandth position having equal marks will also be allowed to take part in the Admission Test examination.

Number of Seats and procedure of Selection

The maximum total number of seats in the first year B. Arch. degree course of 5 years duration is 50 of which 1 seat is reserved for the candidates from Chittagong Hill Tracts and other Tribal Areas of Bangladesh. Candidates from Tribal Areas must submit certificate from the Principal of the College from which they passed H.S.C. examination or First Class Gazetted Officer or the Chairman of local Union Parishad to bear out their claim for the reserved seat and **must indicate in the Application Form that they belong to Tribal Area**. Candidates for the reserved seat must fulfil the minimum qualification requirements and must get the minimum qualifying marks in the Admission Test examination.

A list of successful candidates based only on their merit position in the Admission Test examination will be published. In case of tie in the Admission Test examination result, merit position will be determined on the basis of higher marks obtained in the 2nd Part of the Admission Test examination. Marks obtained in Free-hand Drawing will be considered next.
