Notice of admission into C-in-Ed Course in  
Primary Training Institute

Applications are invited from external candidates for admission into one-year-long C-in-Ed Course of 1986-87 academic session in the Government Primary Training Institutes. Admission seeking candidates have to take part in admission tests at Primary Training Institutes of their respective area or at any one of their conveniences and they will be admitted on the basis of the results of said tests. From the current academic session, admission of candidates will also be made in the Rangamati PTI. Seats for external male and female candidates are 50:50 respectively. In selecting external candidates, 20% (twenty per cent) of the seats will be reserved for the eligible dependents of working or retired teachers of government primary schools. If required number of dependent candidates are not available, the seats reserved for them will be fulfilled by external candidates.

Majority of the selected trainees will get stipend at the rate of Tk. 150/- per month on merit basis. Distribution of stipend among male and female candidates will be on 50:50 basis. Stipend holders have to sign a bond to the effect that they would, for the requirement of the government, will serve in the primary schools as teachers for minimum 5 (five) years after successful completion of their course. External candidates should take training from the particular institute from where they would take part in the admission test. Under no circumstances they will be transferred to other place. Any trainee who will not remain present at 80 per cent classes cannot take part in the examination of that academic session and one's admission will be considered as rejected if he/she remains absent from classes for consecutive 15 (fifteen) days.

The following conditions must be fulfilled for making application :—

1. Minimum educational qualification :— Male candidate—H.S.C|Fazil. But there must be one 2nd division in any of the SSC|Alim or HSC|Fazil. There should be English and Bengali in Alim and Fazil examinations.  
Female candidate — SSC Second Division.
2. Age (on 1.7.86) :— 17 to 25 years. Relaxable upto 30 years in case of teachers working in private educational institutions.
3. Nationality :— Citizen of Bangladesh.

Admission seeking candidates must submit their applications to the Superintendent concerned by 16th June, 1986 on plain paper mentioning name, father's name, date of birth,

permanent address, educational qualifications with division etc, along with a fee of Tk. 10 (ten) only. Two copies passport size photographs and attested copies of educational certificates must be enclosed with application. Written examination will be held on Thursday, 19th June, 1986 at 10.00 a.m. at the Primary Training Institutes. Superintendents will announce the time and date of viva examination.

NOTE : If reserved seats for teachers working in govt. primary schools remain vacant, those external candidates who will get qualifying marks in admission test and interested to take training without stipend may be admitted at male:female ratio on merit basis subject to signing a bond to the above effect.
