Applications are invited from the bona-fide Bangladeshi nationals for award of 11 (eleven) scholarships offered by the Council of Mutual Economic Assistance (CMEA) for studies in Bulgaria, Hungary and Poland in the Academic year 1986-87 in the subject and levels as mentioned below:-

2. While all other expenses will be borne by the donor country/organisation, cost of air passage from Bangladesh to Bulgaria, Hungary and Poland will have to be borne by the finally selected candidates. An undertaking in this respect will have to be attached with the application by the applicant that he/she would bear the travel expenses (bothways).
3. Persons in service must apply through proper channel.
4. Persons who have already availed of foreign scholarships and have not completed a minimum period of 5 (five) years stay/service in Bangladesh on return from abroad need not apply. Age of applicants for post-graduate courses must not exceed 35 years.
5. None need apply for undergraduate scholarships, who have secured less than a total of 1500 marks in SSC & HSC combined.
5. (A) Filing of false information including false marksheets will make the candidate liable for action as per provisions of the criminal law.
6. Applications on plain paper giving the following particulars together with 2 attested copies of each certificates/marksheets, testimonials etc. must reach the undersigned by the 14th June 1987 at the latest. Applicants may also drop their applications in the wooden box kept in the Reception Room, 2nd Gate, Bangladesh Secretariat, Dhaka.
7. Incomplete applications and those received after the closing date will automatically stand cancelled.
