Applications are invited from bonafide citizens of Bangladesh for East-West Centre's (Hawaii) 1987 degree Study Awards. These study grants are offered to highly promising foreign nationals from Asian and Pacific countries on competitive basis and for Master and Ph. D. degree in a wide variety of disciplines at the various institutions of the University Hawaii.

2. The candidates who fulfil the following conditions should only apply:—

- | 1. Subject | Educational qualifications: |
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| (a). Engineering subjects | First Division/Class with 65% marks from SSC to BSc. Engineering Examinations). |
| (b). Humanities and Social Sciences including American Literature and American History | Upper 2nd Class both in Hons. & Masters degree (not less than 58% marks) with at least first Division in SSC & HSC Examinations. |
| (c). Science subjects including Agriculture | First Class both in Hons & Masters Degree with 65% marks and first Division in SSC & HSC (in the event either the Bachelor's or the Masters is below 58% for Humanities and Social Sciences and below 65% for Science, the applicant must secure 65% marks in the Intermediate). |
| (d). Commerce | First Class both in Hons. & Masters Degree with 60% marks and 1st Divn. in SSC & HSC Examinations. |

2. Be not over 35 years of age.
3. Not have studies in the USA previously.
4. Be in Bangladesh at the time of selection.
5. Be very good in English.
6. Be in good health.
7. Return to Bangladesh on completion of studies in Hawaii.
8. Preference will be given to those who have already taken Test of English As a Foreign Language (TOEFL) and either Graduate Record Examination (GRE) or Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT) and scored minimum 550 in TOEFL and 1300 and 500 in GRE and GMAT respectively.
3. The Study Grant includes (a) round-trip Economy Class air-fare (b) a monthly maintenance stipend of US \$384 (c) free housing at East-West Centre dormitory or a housing allowances of \$230 p.m. plus free tuition fee, book allowance and health and accident insurance.
4. Persons already in service must apply through proper channel.
5. Incomplete applications received after 29th May, 1986 will be rejected without assigning any reasons.
