## Subject: Commonwealth Scholarship for 1987-88

Applications are invited from bona fide citizens of Bangladesh for selection of candidates for Commonwealth Scholarships tenable in the U.K., Canada, Hongkong, Trinidad and Jamaica etc. for higher studies at post-graduate/Research level in the subjects mentioned below from the academic year 1987.

2. The candidates who fulfil the minimum academic qualifications mentioned against the subjects below, and other conditions should only apply:-

- i). Economics, Agricultural Economics, Public Administration, Educational Planning, Business Administration, Management, Marketing, Accounting, Finance, Geography, English, Sociology/Rural Sociology, Psychology, Philosophy, History/Islamic History, Archaeology, International Relations, Law, Political Science, Journalism & Mass Communication, Linguistics.
- ii). Physics/Applied Physics and Electronics, Computer Science/Computer Engineering, Chemistry, Soil Science, Mathematics, Statistics, Zoology, Botany, Geology, Histology with Tissue Culture, Pharmacy, Bio-Chemistry, Food Technology/Nutrition, Micro-Biology, Marine Biology, Forestry, and
- iii). Agriculture (all branches)
- iv). Engineering (all branches)
- v). Textile Technology/ Leather Technology (all branches)
- vi). Urban and Regional Planning.
- vii). Medical Science (all branches),
- First class either in Hons. or Master's degree and a 1st Division either in S.S.C. or H.S.C. Examination with 2nd class/Division in the remaining examinations. Candidates who wish to undertake Post-graduate study in Business Administration, Marketing, Accounting, Finance should have taken GMAT and should have secured satisfactory scores.
- First class both in Hons. and Master's degree examinations and at least one first and one 2nd Division in S.S.C. and H.S.C. examinations.
- First class B.Sc. (Engg.) B.Sc. (Architecture) with 1st Division in S.S.C. and H.S.C. examinations.
- Must have a degree in Textile Technology/Leather Technology preferably with 1st Division in S.S.C. or H.S.C. and at least a second Division in the other.
- Master degree in Urban & Regional Planning with 1st class in Civil Engineer or Architecture or with a Master's degree in Economics, Sociology or Geography, having at least one 1st class either in Hon's or in Master degree.
- M.B.B.S./B.D.S. degree (regular with 1st Division in S.S.C. & H.S.C. examinations. Candidates should possess qualifications registerable with General Medical Council in the U.K.

3. Scholarships in Medical subjects are available in U.K. only. Medical candidates who are interested for doing M.R.C.P., F.R.C.S. etc., shall be given preference if they have already completed first part of such examination.

4. Candidates should not over be 35 years of age on 1st October, 1987. Applications already holding a Doctorate degree are not eligible.

5. Persons in service must apply through proper channel. Candidates who availed of Government sponsored scholarships for a period of 3 (three) months and above but have not completed a minimum period of 5 years service/stay in Bangladesh on return from abroad, are also not eligible.

6. Candidates may be required to appear for a proficiency test in English to be conducted by the British Council, Dhaka.

7. Seven copies of applications on plain paper in one envelope giving the following particulars together with attested copies of certificates, diplomas, degree, marksheets, testimonials, etc, should reach the undersigned by 25-10-1986 AT THE LATEST. Applicants may also drop their applications in the wooden box kept in the reception room, 2nd Gate, Bangladesh Secretariat, Dhaka. Incomplete applications and those received after the last date will automatically stand rejected.
