**Notice for Admission into The
First Year Degree Course**

Applications in prescribed form are invited by Bangladesh Agricultural University from candidates eligible to sit for written test for selection for admission into the following first years degree course in different Faculties for the academic session 1986-87.

1. Degree in Veterinary medicine (D.V.M.)
2. Degree in Agriculture (Hons.)
3. Degree in Animal Husbandry (Hons.)
4. Degree in Agricultural Economics (Hons.)
5. Degree in Agricultural Engineering & Technology (Hons.)
6. Degree in Fisheries (Hons.)

For this academic session in the first year Degree course the seat reserved for the students are as follows (1) Faculty of Veterinary Science- 55 (2) Faculty of Agriculture- 250, (3) Faculty of Animal Husbandry- 40, (4) Faculty of Agricultural Economics & Rural Sociology- 50, (5) Faculty of Agricultural Engineering & Technology- 60, (6) Faculty of Fisheries- 60. Total seats- 515.

Besides this, six seats, one seat for each faculty, shall be kept reserved outside the fixed quota for tribal students (male/female). For the admission of students (male/female) specially qualified in sports and cultural activities, 12 students (male/female) will be admitted having distinction in sports and games and six students (male/female) will be admitted having distinction in literature and culture.

Minimum qualification for admission:

a) Only those students who after passing their S.S.C. or equivalent examination in science group in 1983 & 1984 have later on passed their H.S.C. or equivalent examination are eligible to apply.

(b) Students of Science group who have secured average 55% marks out of the total marks of both the S.S.C. & H.S.C. or equivalent examination and at least a second division in each examination will be considered eligible to apply for admission into 1986-87 session with the following conditions:

(1) Candidates for admission should secure at least 45% marks in each of the subject of Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics or Biology.

(2) Candidates intending to apply for admission into the faculty of Agricultural Engineering Technology should have secured minimum 50% marks in mathematics in the H.S.C. Examination.

(3) Candidates intending to apply for admission into the Faculty of Agricultural Economics & Rural Sociology, should have secured minimum 45% marks in mathematics & minimum 40% marks in both Bengali & English in H.S.C. examinations.

(4) Candidates intending to apply for admission in to the Faculty of Veterinary Science & in the Faculty of Fisheries must have obtained 40% marks in Biology in H.S.C. Examination.

Rules for application for admission:

Application form for admission and admission guide can be obtained from all the Branches of Pubali Bank located in the different district headquarters and in the branch situated in the premises of Agricultural University on payment of total amount Tk. 50/- (fifty). Admission programme will be governed by the rules incorporated in the admission guide. Admission form duly filled in must reach directly or by post to the "Convener Council of Deans" faculty of agriculture, Bangladesh Agricultural University, District. Mymensingh by 10th March, 1987.

Rules for application for the reserved seats for the tribal student (male/female).

Tribal students (male/female) shall have to sub-

mit certificate to treat as tribals, collected from the principal of the college from which he has passed or from a first class gazetted officer or Chairman of the local Union Parishad/Headman & "Application for reserved seat" should be written on the top of the application.

Selection for participation in the written test examination:

All applicants who fulfil the conditions for application stated above shall be called to seat for the written test.

Prescribed time-schedule of all programmes regarding admissions:

Last date of receiving application form directly 10th March, 1987, or by post by the Convener, Council of Dean & Tuesday 4-30 P.M. Dean, Faculty of Agriculture, Bangladesh Agricultural University, Mymensingh.

Date for written selection test.

20th April, 1987 Monday

Written selection test:

One examination will be held centrally for all faculties, there will be total 100 marks in written test and the time limit will be 2 hours According to H.S.C. syllabus, following subjects for written test shall be included (a) Physics, (b) Chemistry, (c) Mathematics, (d) Biology, (e) Combined science (shall be framed combined with physics, chemistry, mathematics or biology). Twenty five marks shall be allocated for each aforementioned subject and each candidate shall have to answer to questions on four subjects including chemistry and physics.

Merit score:— (a) The marks secured in the two examinations S.S.C. and H.S.C. will be converted into 40 taking 2% out of the total of 2000 marks.

(b) The final merit list of the successful candidates will be prepared by adding the marks secured out of 40 (converted S.S.C. & H.S.C.) with the total marks secured out of 100 marks for written selection test. The number of candidates in the final merit list shall be equal to the number of seats limited for admission.

(c) Besides the Admission Committee shall make waiting list of candidates in order of merit. If any candidate from the final merit lists does not get admitted then in such case students (male/female) will be admitted in order of merit from the waiting list of candidates.

(d) It is mentioned that those who will remain absent in the written selection test or those who will secure less than 30 marks in the written selection test, will not be counted in the merit score.

Option:

Order of priority for selection of faculty The number of priority must be mentioned against the name of faculty in the application form expressing the desire of individual candidates intending to get admitted into the first year class of the six faculties of the University in the stated education year. The candidates if willing can express the desire for admission into the faculties in order of priority. And the order of the choice cannot be changed afterwards under any circumstances. Incomplete, irregular and indistinct applications will be treated as rejected straightaway.

Candidates shall not be allowed any travelling allowance on behalf of the University to appear before the selection test and the University shall have no responsibility in respect of their food and lodging.

At present there is shortage of seat in the Hall. For that reason assurance cannot be given to the admitted students (male/female) to allot seat in the hall and the admitted students (male/female) shall have to arrange for their food and lodging at their own responsibility.
