

Hajee Danesh Agri College opens in Oct

Country's third agricultural college in Dinajpur in commemoration of late Hajee Mohammad Danesh will be formally inaugurated by President Hussain Muhammad Ershad in October this year, a PID press release said, reports BSS.

This was disclosed on Thursday in a review meeting on 'Establishment of Hajee Mohammad Danesh Agricultural College' held in the Agriculture Ministry with its Minister Major Gen. (Retd) Mahmudul Hasan in the chair.

Chairman, Dinajpur district Council, Mr. Mokhlesur Rahman, MP, Agriculture Secretary M.A. Syeed and other high officials of the ministry were present in the meeting.

The meeting decided that 60 students will be enrolled initially in early October this year and admission test in this connection will be conducted simultaneously in Dhaka and Dinajpur.

The proposal for setting up of Hajee Danesh Agricultural College at Basherhat, Dinajpur, was enunciated by President Ershad at a public meeting during his recent visit to the northern region of the country. With the enrolment of students the long felt demand of the northern region for higher education in agriculture will be fulfilled.

Thirteen departments of the Hajee Mohammad Danesh Agriculture College will offer degree in various disciplines of agricultural science, the handout said.
