2. The seats are available in the universities/institutions of Pakistan on purely self-financing basis. However, the Government of Pakistan is likely to offer two scholarships against two seats under the existing Cultural Exchange Programme between the two Governments.

Applications on plain paper giving the following particulars together with two attested copies of marksheets, certificates testimonials and two copies of passport-size photographs must reach the undersigned by 25-10-88 at the latest. Candidates may also drop their applications in the wooden box kept in the Reception Room, 2nd Gate (gate No 5) Bangladesh Secretariat, Dhaka.

4. Incomplete applications and those received after the closing date will automatically stand cancelled.

5. Persons submitting false marksheets shall be prosecuted under the Penal Code.
