Notice for Admission of Students in the 'Artisan Course' at the Textile Technology Training Centres

1. Intending candidates are invited to apply in prescribed form available with the Centres for admission into 1 year long 'Artisan Course' at the Textile Technology Training Centres. Last date fixed for reaching applications in 15 June 1989.

2. Subjects of training :

(a) Manufacturing cloth in handloom, (b) Dyeing of cloth, (c) Screen printing, (d) Garment technology (cutting and sewing), (e) Technology of manufacturing sock, muffler and sweater in hand knitting machine, (f) Technology of making quilt, matting and 'paposh' from coconut rind.

3. Qualification :

(a) Boys and girls having minimum education upto Class VIII may apply.
(b) Age — Not above 20 years.

(c) Nationality : Candidates must be citizens of Bangladesh.

4. Address for obtaining application form :

Application form and prospectus containing detailed terms and conditions for admission at Textile Technology Training Centres may be collected by sending an envelope of 9" x 4" size containing own address and affixed with stamp, or from the Superintendent of the concerned centre in which admission is sought, on payment of a pay order/bank draft/postal order of Tk 10/- favouring the Director, Textile Directorate, Dhaka. Filled in application form must be submitted in the Centre the candidate seeking admission.

6. Selective Test :

Candidates will have to remain present at the concerned centres for interview/viva examinations at 9 am on Sunday, 2.7.89. No interview card will be issued for attending the selective test. Selected candidates will also not be informed by any kind of communication. Results should be known from the notice board kept at the office of the Centre Superintendents.

7. Date fixed for starting training :

Selected candidates will take part in the training course with effect from 22 July 1989.

8. Other necessary information :

a) Artisan Course pass certificate is awarded after completion of the 1 year long training course. Certificate holders get employment in various textile, jute and garment industries of the country. Apart from this, the said training course is aimed at creating self-employment opportunities for the trainees after completion of the course since the training is conducted on fully practical basis.

b) There is arrangement of loan for purchasing machine/loom in view of creating employment opportunities for the meritorious amongst the candidates passed the training course under Development Planning which will be applicable to those candidates who would come out successful in 1989-90 academic session.

9. Monthly scholarship :

Every student is given scholarship of Tk 100/- per month subject to regular attendance and satisfactory conduct.

10. Mill training :

Every year mill training arrangement for 2 months is made for 5 passed-out students from every centre at local mills and factories; and monthly allowance of Tk 200/- is paid during mill training period.
