



SCHOLARSHIP NOTICE

Applications are invited from Bonafide Bangladeshi nationals for two scholarships under USAID Technical Assistance, in the following Fields:

1. **Agricultural Economics**
 2. **Rural Sociology**
- A minimum of two first classes are required in their educational career. Applicants holding third class in any examination during their educational career need not apply.
- a) Candidates for scholarship in Agricultural Economics should have Master's Degree with Honours of Agricultural Economics and formal training in Intermediate Micro and Macro-economic theory in Statistical methods in operation research and in economic trials. They should have a working knowledge of calculus and linear algebra. Experience in the use of computers for economic analysis is desirable.
- b) Candidates for Rural Sociology must have Rural Sociology as a subject in their Masters Degree programme and should have formal training in sociological theory, research methods and quantitative analysis. They should have working knowledge of calculus and linear algebra. Experience in the use of computers in sociological and for development research is desirable.

A command of English at a level to pass the TOEFL with a score of least 520 is required for both scholarships. Candidates who already have a score of 520 or above will be preferred.

3. Candidates who are in service will be required to apply through proper channel. Age of the candidates on 31.5.89 shall not exceed 35 years.
4. The following documents/papers etc. should be enclosed with the application:
 - a) Two attested copies of passport size photographs
 - b) Attested copies/photocopies of Original Marksheet/Certificates and other testimonials/papers.
 - c) Two sets of application as per proforma in 7, should reach the Director, IPSA, Salna, Gazipur on or before 25th April/1989, beyond which no application will be accepted.
5. Incomplete applications will be rejected.
6. During the period of their studies abroad, successful candidates will receive a training allowance as per rules from IPSA in Bangladesh.
7. Application will be written in English, as per form quoted below:
