

Call to improve standard of education

RAJSHAHI, Aug. 2 (BSS): The Jatiya Party Secretary General and Deputy Prime Minister, Shah Moazzem Hossain, today called upon the conscious section in the society particularly the political leaders, teachers and students to ensure a congenial academic atmosphere in the educational institutions.

Addressing the Rajshahi district Jatiya Party at the Zila Parishad auditorium, Shah Moazzem said in an independent country like Bangladesh, it was the responsibility of all concerned to guide the student community to their primary job of equipping themselves with knowledge for shouldering the future leadership of the country.

He pointed out that the government of President Ershad was making all out efforts to ensure proper academic atmosphere in the campus and improvement of the standard of education in the country.
