



## Barek appointed Ambassador to Kuwait

The Government has decided to appoint Mr M. A. Barek, as Ambassador of Bangladesh to the State of Kuwait, says an official announcement.

Mr M. A. Barek was born on January 1, 1934.

He obtained his B.A. (Hons.) in Political Science in 1954, Masters Degree in Political Science and had his LL.B. in 1960 from Dacca University.

He enrolled as an Advocate in the Dacca High Court in 1961. He was honorary lecturer of Barisal Law College from 1963 to 1974. He practices as an Advocate in the Supreme Court of Bangladesh.

Mr M. A. Barek was elected to the then National Assembly of Pakistan in 1970. He was member of the central committee and now a member of national council of Bangladesh Nationalist Party.
