



Tasadduque Lohani dead

The eminent educationist and juvenile litterateur Mr. Abul Khayer Mohammad Tasadduque Hossain Khan Lohani died after a prolonged illness at his Ullapara residence in Pabna on November 13. He was 70. S-211

Mr. Tasadduque Lohani took his M. A. degree in English Literature from the Calcutta University and later took B.T. degree. He started his teaching career as Headmaster in a private high school at Kendua in Burdwan district in the early forties. Mr. T. Hossain retired as the Headmaster of Pabna Zilla School in 1975. He was well-known to the literary and cultural circles of Pabna.

During his student life, he used to edit a paper named "Sabuj Pata" in 1941. Mr. Lohani is the author of "Rupkather Mayapuri", "Rupkather Mayamukur" and "Rupkather Swapnapuri" all juvenile literature.

He was the uncle of late Mr. Fateh Lohani Mr. Fazle Lohani and Mr. Kamal Lohani.

Mr. Lohani was also a sportsman and had valuable contributions to this arena.

He was buried at Ullapara. The qul khawani of the late educationist was held on November 16.
