## Writer Sattar's name included in WHO's WHO

Abdus Sattar, an outstanding writer and scholar of Bangladesh is included this year in WHO's WHO In The Commonwealth and Men Of Achievement published by the International Biographical Centre, London says a Press release.

Before this, he has had the opportunity to become familiar abroad for inclusion of his life sketch and references in the world famous prestigious Publications like Dictionary of



World Anthropologists, Directory of Asian Writers, Encyclopedia of Britannica, Encyclopedia De Paris etc.

Mr Sattar has got to his credit some 65 publications on poetry books of research, translation works and books for children. Some of his English books like In the Sylvan Shadows Tribal Culture in Bangladesh The Sowing of Seeds etc. have been included in the syllabus of foreign Universities dealing with the tribal people of Asian Countries.

He received the Dawood Prize for Literature in 1966 Bangla Academy Prize for literature in 1975 and Abul Mansur Sahitya Purushkar in 1980.

Born in February 1, 1931 at village Golara in the district of Tangail Mr. Abdus Sattar is the son of late Moutri Abdus Sobhan.
