



Dr Muniruzzaman passes away

Eminent surgeon of the country Prof. Muniruzzaman died of heart failure at the Institute of Cardiovascular Diseases at 8.50 a.m. on Friday. He was 55.

The mortal remains of Prof. Zaman was buried at the Banani Graveyard in the afternoon. Namaj-e-Janaza was held at the Baitul Mokarram mosque after Juma prayer. The Janaza was largely attended by his friends relatives and admirers. He was admitted to the hospital on Wednesday following heart ailment. Prof. Zaman was Head of the Department of Surgery of Dhaka Medical College Hospital and was a former Director of IPGMR.

After the Janaza the body of Prof. Zaman was brought to the Dhaka Medical College Hospital and his fellow colleagues medical students and hospital employees gathered to have a last glimpse of the late Professor.

Prof. Zaman graduated from the Dhaka Medical College in the year 1950. He did his FRCS

from Royal College of Surgery of England in 1962. He hailed from Gaibandha subdivision in Rangpur district. He left behind his widow a daughter and a number of friends and host to mourn his death.

DEATH CONDOLED

They said that Prof. Zaman had contributed a lot for the development of the medical science in the country. In another statement Dr. Asfer Hossain Mollah and Dr. Abdur Rahman President and General Secretary of the Bangladesh Assistant Surgeons Association has said that the premature demise of Prof. Zaman has created a vacuum in the country's medical science and it was an irreparable loss for the nation.
