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BUET admission 5700 applications for 510 seats in Engg depts

A total of 5700 application forms for the Engineering departments (Chemical, Civil, Computer Electrical and Electronic, Mechanical, Metallurgy, Naval Architecture and Marine Engineering and 3300 for Architecture department) have been received by the Registrar of BUET on Monday, the last date for submitting admission forms for the academic session 1986-87.

Only the first 3500 candidates, selected on the basis of the marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics, in Higher Secondary Certificate Examination will be allowed to sit for examination for Engineering departments while the first 3000 applicants will be permitted to appear at the admission test for architecture department.

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A candidate who have secured minimum 65 per cent marks on average and 50 per cent marks separately in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics in H.S.C. examination is eligible for admission test for the engineering departments. on the other hand a candidate requires a minimum second division with 50 per cent marks on average excluding the additional subjects in H.S.C exam to appear for admission test for the Architecture.

The total number of seats in the engineering departments is 510 (Chemical-40, Civil-155, Computer-30, Electrical and Electronic-130, Mechanical-130 Metallurgy-15 name-10) and that of the Architecture is 50 i.e. about 11 candidates in Engineering and 66 in Architecture are contesting for one seat in those departments.

The names of the eligible candidates for both the department will be published on January 14 and the admission test for Engineering and Architecture will be held on February 4 and 5 respectively.
