

## Admission test of DU Kha unit cancelled

The Dhaka University authorities on Tuesday cancelled the "Kha" unit admission test for first year honours classes to remove the confusion of public and maintain the sanctity of the admission test.

The "Kha" unit admission test was held on April 21 and there was allegation that the questions were leaked and sold to students at different halls of the university a day before the examination.

The university authorities took this decision reviewing the report of the enquiry committee formed by the University Vice-Chancellor Prof. Emajuddin Ahamed to investigate the allegation regarding the leakage of questions, says a Press release.

Fresh date of "Kha" unit admission test will be announced soon, the Press release added.

The enquiry committee in its report submitted to university author-

ities on Tuesday opined that although the allegation of leakage of questions was not proved clearly there are some doubts about the incident.

The authorities are taking step soon for further indepth investigation into the allegation by competent agencies.

Meanwhile, the pro-Awami League Chhatra League (S-P) brought out a procession and held a rally on the campus demanding cancellation of admission test for first year honours classes.

Addressing the rally at Aparajeo Bangla they accused the authorities of leaking the questions of the examination and demanded punishment of those responsible for the incident.

The rally was addressed by Ishaq Ali Khan Panna, Bahadur Bepari and Abdul Wadud Khokan.
