## New admission system resented

The SSC-HSC Examinees Action Committee has resented the new admission procedure, that will take in students according to their performance in the immediate past examination.

They pointed out that the students were not notified about this well in advance. Moreover, it was even after some colleges had completed their admission tests, that the public was aware of the new system which the government has introduced.

They mentioned that the computerised tabulation system also has its faults, as it has already been reported in many papers that thousands of students have wrong results because of some mistakes during "input". Tampering authorities of some unscrupulous personnel of different education board also cause undue harassment for a large number of students.

Meanwhile the SSC-HSC Examinees Action Committee said, that the minister for education of this government, which has introduced the recent admission procedure, that is meant to put a brake to the 'coaching culture', has himself given a flattering message in favour of it. It is printed in a publicity brochure of one of the leading coaching centres - "Shuvechhya". The message was ironically in support of the coaching centre.
