BAU students union team call on Shahabuddin

A nine-member delegation of the Central Students Union of the Bangladesh Agriculture University, Mymensingh, met the Acting President, Mr. Justice Shahabuddin Ahmed, at President's secretariat in Dhaka on Wednesday, reports BSS.

The delegation, led by A.K.M. Abdur Rafique, Vice President of the Union, discussed with the Acting President various problems facing the students including accommodation, transport and session jam.

The students delegation informed Acting President that the University at present had only four buses. They also made special request for expansion of the present women hall as it cannot accommodate 450 girl students of the university. They also informed the Acting President that the construction work on the University central mosque, which was started long ago, has not been completed as yet. The student leaders requested the Acting President to give special attention in this regard. They also urged him to arrange for providing an ambulance.

About employment facilities for Agriculture graduates, the student leaders requested for filling up the existing vacant posts without delay by appointment on adhoc basis as was done in the case of medical graduates.

Justice Shahabuddin said that all the universities of the country have been facing almost similar transport and accommodation problems. However, he said he would look into the problems.

The delegation included, among others, Mohammad Awalad Hussain, General Secretary and Md. Hasmat Ara Chowdhury, a central leader.
