8 BAU teachers removed from service

MYMENSINGH, Apr. 24:— Eight teachers of Bangladesh Agricultural University have been removed from their service recently. The teachers who had been staying abroad for higher study did not come back although the scheduled time of their course or period of approved leave was over.

The university authority issued several notices to the concerned teachers to join their place of work failing which disciplinary action would not be taken against them.

As these teachers had been staying abroad the sanctioned leave and did not submit satisfactory reply the university authority took the disciplinary action against them.

The names and designations of the removed teachers could not be known.

It may be mentioned here that a teacher of the university should be allowed maximum six year's leave for performing higher education and during this period he would get his salary regularly.

At present 50 teachers of the university have been staying abroad and on an average 40 to 50 teachers of the university have to stay abroad for higher education and other purposes every year.
