BAU hall raided: JCD leaders held

MYMENSINGH, Nov 2:— Police and Bangladesh Rifles in a joint raid arrested three leaders of Bangladesh Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal from Bangladesh Agricultural University (BAU) campus this morning.

The arrested leaders are identified as central leader of JCD and President BAU unit of JCD Hasan Jafar Tuhin, General Secretary of BAUC-SU and reader of JCD Shamsul

Aram Tofa and a JCD leader Liaquat Ali. After arrest of the leaders, chase and counter-chases occurred between the workers of JCD and Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL). The agitated workers of the organisations ransacked about 20 rooms and set ablaze several rooms of the university.

It is learnt that 3 platoons of Bangladesh Rifles and police of Kotwali thana in a joint raid arrested Tuhin from a room of Shahjalal Hall, Tofa from the house of Harun-Al-Rashid lecturer of Agri-Economics faculty and Liaquat Ali from a room of Shamsul Hoque Hall. Following warrants against them and fact that they did not appear in the court after they got bail in several cases. During the rule of BNP these leaders were arrested for several times.

It is mentionable that Tuhin who was a student of the university was expelled from the university, for terrorism several years ago.

After arrest these leaders and the workers of BCL brought out a procession in the university campus. They also demanded arrest of all terrorists of the university.

No sound of firing was heard during the ransack and abalze.

The university authority suspended holding of all examinations of the university of today (Sunday).

Tension is being mounted in the university.
