

Tree plantation programme on BAU premises

trees at the different areas of Bangladesh Agricultural University (BAU) in order to build a healthy environment on the campus, says a Press release.

Inaugurating a two-month long Tree Plantation Programm '99 on the BAU Campus, the Vice-Chancellor added that more trees would increase the beautification of the Campus. He said that planted saplings are to be protected from cattleheads for proper maintenance.

It may be mentioned here that 3000 saplings of different varieties including fruit bearing trees will be planted during the period at the BAU Campus.

A colourful rally was brought out to create awareness among the people for planting more trees led by the Vice-Chancellor which was participated in by teachers, students, officers, employees, and various socio-cultural organizations of the University. Later, they planted saplings on the central mosque premises as well as adjacent areas.
