

BOU to launch HSC course

Bangladesh Open University is going to launch HSC programme in July this year to meet the growing demand of the students. A one day workshop of the tutorial centre coordinators for the course was held at NAEM in Dhaka on Friday. About 80 principals from different colleges took part in the workshop. In this workshop, distance education and teaching methodology, admission procedure, examination system and the role of tutorial coordinator to activate the HSC programme of BOU have been discussed. Duration of this course is two years, says a Press release.

The BOU Vice-Chancellor Prof. M Aminul Islam was the chief guest and Prov-VC Prof R.I. Sharif was the special guest at the workshop.

The chief guest in his address, spoke on the need for such type of programmes adding it will cater the needs of the labourers, drop-outs, house-wives and other people who are deprived of having regular education in the country.
