

## 56.74 pc pass in RB SSC exam

**RAJSHAHÍ, June 23:** The results of SSC examination of Board of Intermediate & Secondary Education, Rajshahi was announced on Friday. The overall percentage of pass is 56.74.

In all 38,473 students appeared at the examination of which 21,866 came out successful. Of the successful candidates, 949 secured First Division, 5,637 Second Division and 15,079 Third Division.

Master Abdullah Al Mamun of Rajshahi Cadet College topped the combined merit list securing letter marks in six subjects.
